Joining in and getting Organised

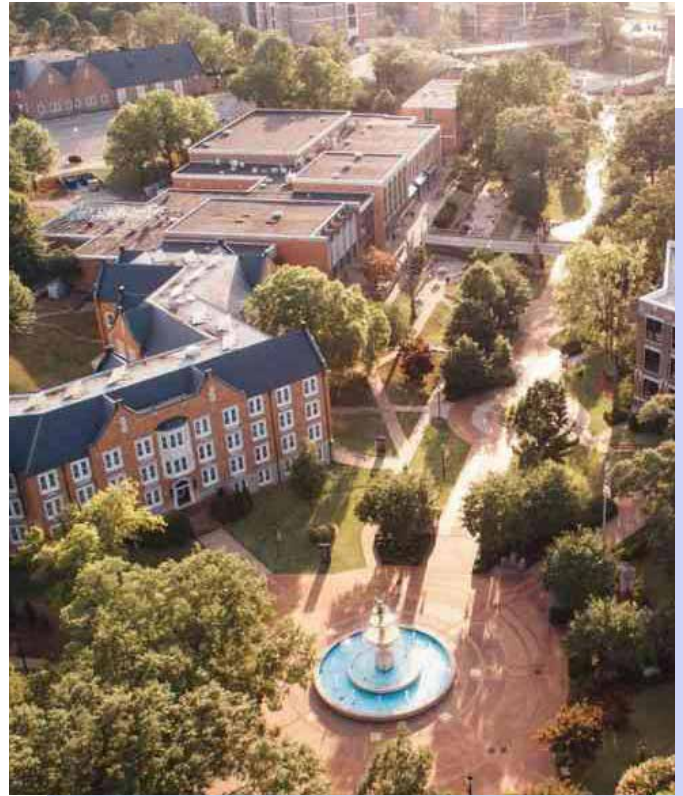

Cultural Immersion In USA

A new Cultural immersion experience is what the students need to be ready for.

It may be getting used to using inches, pounds, and miles or dealing with the brisk pace of walking, talking, and working in New York, but negotiating the United States' etiquette quirks and voluminous unwritten rules can be difficult.

The world-famous American “How are you?” is not so much a question as it is a casual greeting. While “I’m fine, thanks” is a perfectly acceptable answer, going into a 5-minute monologue about how your day has been going so far is not.

Americans are very friendly people and our students who choose our courses based out of America are very lucky as people in USA are the most hospitable and will often go out of their way to make a foreigner feel at home. They also tend to be very direct and open, which can come as a surprise to people coming from more reticent cultures.

Outside of a few big cities, most Americans will only speak English, which means it’ll be tough to communicate through a language barrier—although most Americans will gladly try to help as best they can even if they can’t understand you. Americans are also a bit louder and more chatty than the average person, which can make for some energetic interactions.

Cities on the east coast are easily accessible by train, but many Americans choose to fly because of convenience and price. Even small cities have airports in the United States, and students may find this mode of transportation much easier and cheaper also



Emergency Services

Dialing 911 in USA will put you in contact with a general emergency service dispatcher who will be able to contact police and emergency medical vehicles on your behalf.

The 911 operator will ask you for your location, the phone number you're calling from, and what sort of emergency is happening. After you move to an American city, it's important to have the phone numbers for the local police department, local fire department, local hospital, and the poison control center posted somewhere in your home for easy access.

Sports

Americans love sports. Football, basketball, baseball, and hockey are the four biggest sports by audience in the U.S., with other activities like soccer, stock car racing, tennis, and golf each having a large and dedicated fanbase. You'll hear the American national anthem played before most professional sporting events, and many Americans will stand, remove their hats, and face the flag for the duration of the song.





Tipping

Because of a loophole in labor laws, service employees like waiters and bartenders are legally allowed to be paid less than the mandated minimum wage. That means that they're making as little as a few dollars an hour, and depend on tips from customers to make up the difference in pay. There is a growing movement in some U.S. cities like New York and San Francisco to do away with tipping by paying service employees a livable wage. "No tipping" restaurants will always have signage

explaining that gratuities aren't necessary. Typical guidelines for tipping are between 15% and 20% of the total cost of the bill. (A tipping tip: Move the decimal place in your bill over one place to the left and multiply the resulting amount by two to get 20%.)

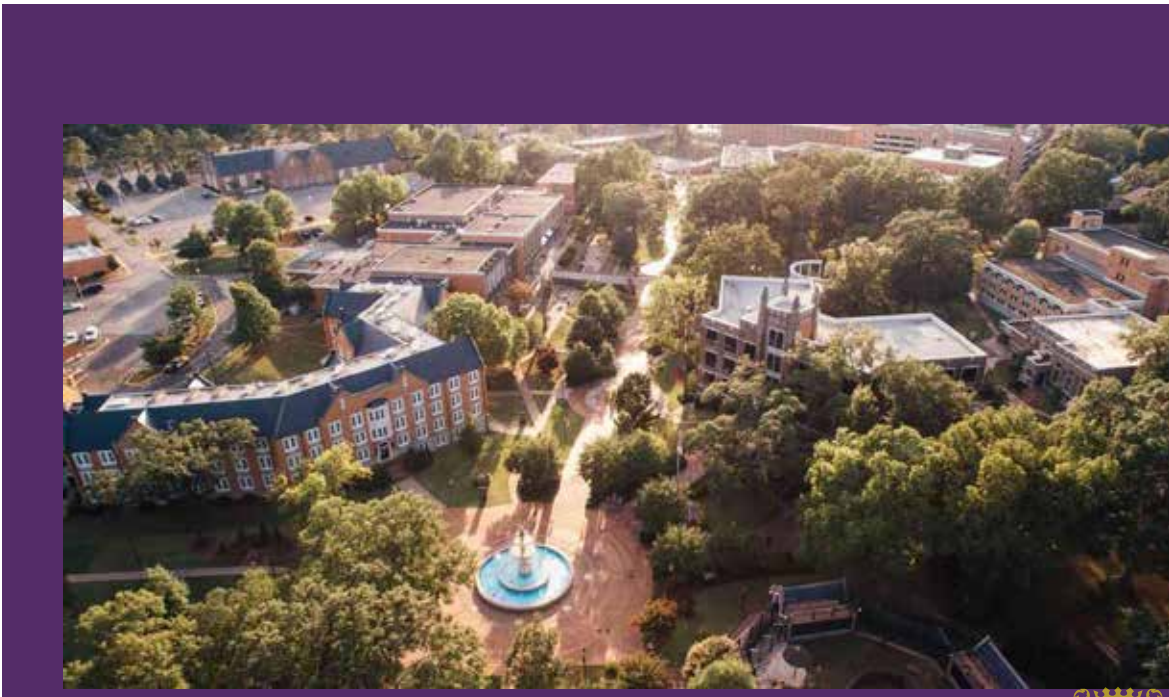

Seven Academic Habits for Success

Whether you're studying for your Bachelor degree, an MBA or simply expanding your knowledge base, these tips will help you get the most out of your study time. We uncover that it's not necessarily about working harder, but how to study smarter.

1. Study in short Sessions

Short study sessions help your brain to process information much better than lots of information in long sessions. Avoid all-nighters, start planning and reading early in the study period and make a study schedule.

2. Get in the zone

Create the ideal study space, and gather all the books and items you will need. Also, limit distractions – if you must listen to music, choose melodic music without lyrics and of course, leave your phone alone and stay away from social media.

3. Sleep well and exercise

You need to be alert, well-fed and rested – and even better if you've exercised. It's important to ensure you've consumed nutritious foods to get your brain powered up – things like fish, nuts, berries and yoghurt. It also pays to stay hydrated and get up to move in between your short study sessions.

4. Connect the dots

Learning to make connections when you consume information pays dividends. While you study, think of the various ways that the information you are reading, watching or listening to is connected to one another. This is called contextual learning.





5. Set goals

Make a list of study goals and tick them off when you complete them. Not only will it motivate you and give you a sense of achievement, it will help you feel in control and reduce any study stress.

6. Test yourself

Practice tests are a good way to see where you're at, and where you might need to focus. There are some great templates that you can find online to help with the structure. If you come across something tricky in your readings, make a note of it and remember to test yourself later for a challenge.

7. Aim to teach it

Tests have shown that people who study material to teach it to others, absorb the information more logically than those who are merely studying for themselves. A US study has shown that students who engaged in peer learning scored significantly higher on a reading test than the students who had not, indicating the effectiveness peer tutoring can have on academic achievement.



STUDY REQUIREMENTS



Almost all the courses offered by CBS are of a similar structure. The first year of your study would be at CBS campus in Bangalore and the second year would be at the University campus abroad where you have made the choice of your study.

Generally, our Master's programs are offered in 4 Semesters consisting of typically 5-6 courses in each semester. The final semester would also have an additional capstone project or an assignment similar to that depending on the program and the university chosen by the student.

Internships are also typically offered in the final year or the final semester if that is a requirement as offered by the University only. University would assist the students in typically applying for an internship and ensuring that the student gets the necessary exposure for his future career prospects.

The first year of studies would happen mostly in an Online mode or a few subjects that may be taught in the offline mode at the Institute's campus here in Bangalore. However, the students would be most welcome and can meet our faculty personally and get the required clarifications during their study time.

Students would be evaluated during the first year based on the number of classes the students would attend either on an online mode or offline mode, the assignments submitted, the faculties assessment of the student in class participation, his general behaviour in the campus and also on the Internal assessment tests that are conducted regularly. Parents would also be updated on a regular basis about the student's performance in the campus.

CBS has a special cell which offers assistance to our students to get themselves placed provided they opt for the placement and internship opportunities while studying here in India. Once the students leave India for a University abroad, they would be eligible for placement and Internship opportunities only after the completion of their second year of study. However, the



students are eligible to work on a part time basis during their student days to earn a few extra dollars and gain some much needed experience. These permits would be well within the rules and regulations of the country that the student has chosen to study from.

Every student is expected to pay all the necessary fee dues towards the Institute well within the time stipulated and not miss any of the time frame. A special permission in writing needs to be taken from the International office of the Institute in case there would be any delay of the payment of fee dues. Any delay in payment would also attract an additional penalty along with the fee for the delayed payment.

The complete second year of the fee towards the foreign University needs to be paid to the International office here in Bangalore at least 3 months before the scheduled departure of the student to the foreign campus to process all the necessary documentations required. The Institute would not be responsible for any cancellation of admission from the foreign University because of the delay caused by the student in paying the fee due. Any application for discontinuing of the programs and refund of the fees is strictly on the refund policy as applicable by the Institute at the time of receiving the application and the rules of the applicable university during that time.

The student is expected to pay his entire fee for the semester at the beginning of the program before he/she is admitted to attend the classes.

The Institute has entered into MOUs with many of the established banks and NBFCs who have agreed to offer educational loans for our students. Of course, the sanctioning or approval of these loans would solely depend on the documentation provided by the applicant as well as the repayment capacity as assessed by the bankers providing the loan.

Students are also expected to keep the necessary amount in their bank accounts at the time of processing their VISA and provide the necessary bank statements to the Institute for further processing of the VISA documents. It is the responsibility of the students/parents to make the necessary arrangements at that point of time for keeping sufficient funds in their bank accounts so that the same can be shown to the embassy officials during VISA processing activity.

It is the responsibility of the Institute to get all the necessary documentations compiled as required by the VISA processing authorities and submit the same to the concerned officials through the services of an agent who would follow it up and ensure a speedy processing of the application. However, sanctioning of the VISA and the type of the VISA is the sole authority of the embassy officials and the Institute would not be held responsible for any rejection cases. Generally, student VISAs are issued with out much hassles if all the documentations are in perfect order.



ASK FOR HELP

Peer support is the most important type of life support that a student can depend on during his student days. It is this support that also brings in life long relationships in many cases. Students find it easier to seek the support of their peers in solving either their personal issues or anything related to their studies also. It would be prudent and better that the help of the peers is sought first and then on special request, a counsellors help also would be provided to the student if sought. But the student needs to ask for help if required.

The student can also take the services of the Student Welfare services that is provided as part of them being our student here in the campus. Senior members of the faculty are a part of the welfare services cell and try to redress any issues that the students would be facing in the campus.

We would have students from different cultures and background, speaking different languages and having grown up in different way of life. This adds up to the equity and diversity that the campus would bring into the life of a student during his tenure of stay with us. Academic support would be forthcoming from the senior members of the faculty be it here in India or abroad if the student approaches by following the necessary protocol correctly.

Students are also given opportunities to participate in the various management festivals, webinars, conferences, seminars etc conducted during their stay in the campus and showcase their talent in such forums.

The Institutes library is well equipped with the books that are required for the student to make his study meaningful at the Institute. He can access the digital facility that is available to enhance his research needs as part of this study here.



TEN TIPS FOR A GREAT FIRST YEAR

1. Remember that every person you meet in college has something to offer you.

You will meet hundreds new people at college – classmates, professors, advisors, recruiters, staff at campus, etc. Naturally, you won't become friends with everyone, but we recommend networking with as many people as possible, especially when you're new at the campus.

2. Be organised and make deadlines your priority.

Get a calendar, whether an online app or good old paper diary, and write down all your deadlines, exams, group meetings and college events. You will have dozens of different assignments during your college years and the sooner you find a routine that fits you, the better. Make it your priority to never hand in an assignment late. Being diligent and dependable is always a plus!

3. Never. Ever. Plagiarize.

Don't even come close to plagiarizing. Learning how to write is one of the core skills you will be developing at university. Don't ruin the learning process with copying and pasting words from a different source. Instead, find enough various resources, learn how to cite sources properly, and develop your own writing routine.

4. Find a note-taking system that works well for you.

Taking notes with a laptop might be faster and easier than writing notes by hand, but writing down notes with good old pen might help you remember the content of the lecture better than if you typed them. Find out what works best for you in each class so you can make the most out of your notes once revising or studying.

5. Always back up your files.

There is nothing worse than having your laptop broke down in the middle of finishing your unsaved essay or losing a whole file of documents.



6. Meet with your academic advisor on a regular basis.

Connect with your school's academic advisor as well as a career center. Both your career advisor and academic advisor might play a valuable role in your college years and in your future decisions. Also, go to most career fairs in the campus or the city you live in, whether you are looking for a job or just want to network with recruiters.

7. Actively participate in activities organised by your university/faculty.

Whether it is extra-curriculum lecture or a Christmas party organised by the faculty, these events are a great opportunity to get to know your classmates, professors and professionals better, but also to learn interesting things.

8. Don't be afraid to drop a class you don't like.

Feel no obligation to take every single class you register for. If you don't like them, drop them and spend your time in a more meaningful class for you. At the end of the day, college is about finding out what you want to do. Attend to those classes which you feel are adding more value to your study.

9. Take good care of your health.

Taking good care of your body and mind is essential every day of your life, but even more when you get to start a brand new chapter at a university, often miles away from your family and home. You will likely face a frequent temptation to eat unhealthy food, cook low-cost meals and miss out on physical exercise due to lack of time. Nevertheless, it is important to keep a healthy lifestyle, eat enough fruits and veggies, drink enough water, sleep well and exercise often. Especially in the times of global pandemic.

10. Get to know your professors.

College is as much about networking as it is about taking classes. Plus, most of professors will be very happy to get to know you, share their experience and guide you through your college path.





YOUR STUDENT VISA

Obtaining a student VISA depends on various factors. The necessary documents required to process the same would be provided by the Institute and the Institute would also help in submitting the same to the concerned officials. It is finally the decision of the embassy officials to issue the same to the students. If all the documentations are correct and in order, there would not be any reason for the student VISA to get rejected unless there are very serious issues pertaining to law & Order.

Students are also expected to keep a stipulated minimum amount in their bank accounts for a period of about 2 to 3 months at the time of VISA processing. The Institute would not be responsible for arranging these funds. It is the sole responsibility of the students/parents to mobilise the necessary funds and get the bank statement as part of the VISA processing activity.

In case of obtaining a VISA to European countries, there is a block account letter that needs to be opened in a specific bank during VISA processing activity. The funds necessary for obtaining this block account letter would also be sole responsibility of the student/parent.

Necessary assistance for obtaining the accommodation in European countries for the students tenure of his

stay would be provided by the International office at the Institute. However, it is not compulsory for the students to go ahead with arrangements as suggested by the office. Any arrangements done on their own is also fine. We request the students to take our advise before finally making your own arrangements for your stay in Europe.

Students are generally treated nicely and it would be a great enjoyable experience for the students to study abroad. Stray cases of exploitation in some countries exist and students need to be vary of such incidents and need to be careful against such exploitation. Favours of any type sought from unscrupulous people need to be reported immediately to your parents and to the Institute authorities. A call to the local police also would help in stopping the menace.

Students also need to equip themselves with the necessary language skills before landing in a country which speaks a language other than English. While most of the Americans can understand and speak English, that would not be the case with Europeans. Depending on the program and the country of your choice, the necessary language skills (both written and spoken) need to be mastered before you actually land in that country for furthering your education.



Graduation and Alumni

All our students would get their degree from the foreign University to which they have enrolled to after the successful completion of their studies. The transcripts of their marks obtained and the certificate of successfully completing the program would be issued by the University concerned. The first year's grades would have been transferred to the partner university from our Institute and they would be part of the transcripts that you would get from the partner University on completion of your course.

All students on successfully completing the course would automatically be a part of the Alumni group of that University from where you graduate and be entitled for all the privileges of being their alumni.

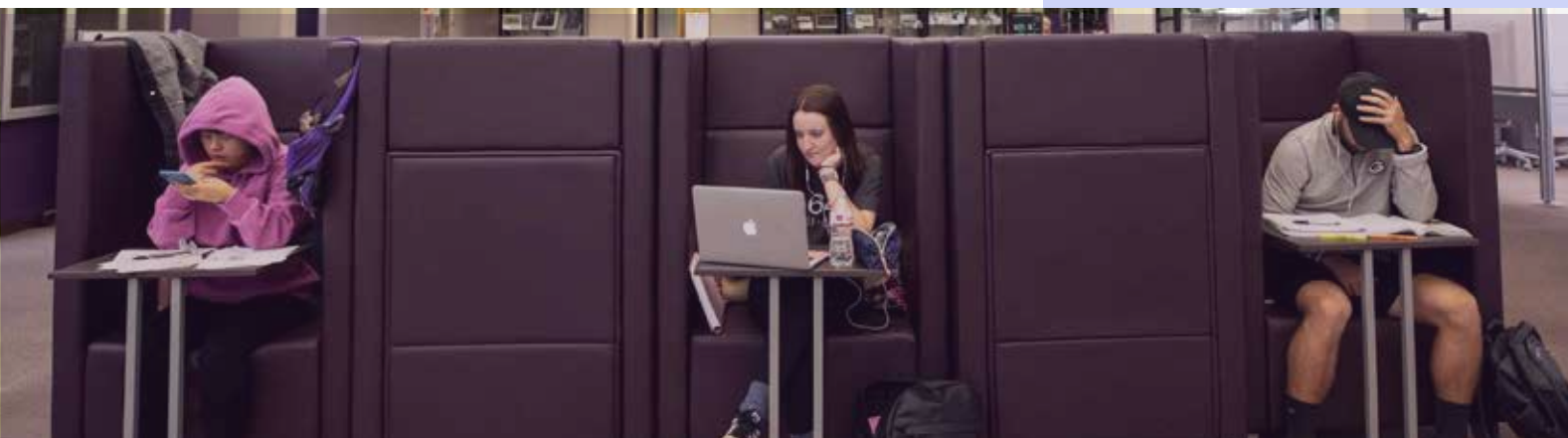

Extra Budgeting

Students if studying in USA campus of North Alabama, the fee structure includes the charges of accommodation and food for one year. If the stay gets extended due to some reason, then there would be extra budgetary expenses to be kept aside and that would be as per the University rules and regulations as applicable during that time.

Local transportation cost, any extra food or beverages that the student would want to enjoy during his stay would be at extra cost.

Students studying in Europe would have to make their own arrangements for their stay and food. However, it would be possible for our counsellors to give you fair idea of how much that would cost if you personally meet them here at our International office at the campus.

LIVING OFF CAMPUS

If students have other ideas and would like to stay separately and not in the accommodation provided by the University, then the arrangements would have to be done by the student himself and the complete cost has to be born by the student. No refund, discounts or adjustments would be possible from the original fee collected in such cases.



TOP THINGS TO DO ON CAMPUS

1. Take a campus tour

Campus tours are a great place to start your campus visit. You'll learn about the campus landmarks, history of the school and a little bit about the campus lifestyle.



2. Sit in on a class

Attending a class in your study area of interest lets you get a feel for class size, structure and learning style. For a better idea of the school's coursework and teaching philosophies, consider sitting in on two or three classes, and talk to professors after class.

3. Read a student newspaper

This would help you gauge the issues that students on campus care about and what social and academic events occur during the school year. You'll find college newspapers in common areas such as cafeterias and building entry halls.



4. Make a list of questions

Create a list of questions for admissions officers, financial aid representatives, faculty and students, and bring it with you when you want to meet your counsellors personally. Thinking through your questions before you visit colleges and universities will make your college search easier.

5. Live the student lifestyle

If possible, stay overnight in the dorms, walk through the library and eat in the school cafeteria. This gives you a chance to act like a student for a day and see if you like it.



6. Go to a game or campus party

Attending a college game or party gives you additional firsthand insight into campus culture. Strict parents? Get their okay before you head off to that party.

7. Check book prices at the bookstore

Look at course offerings and textbook pricing. Be sure to check prices on books that may be required for your intended program so you know how much to budget for books if you attend that college.



8. Take a tour of the surrounding town

Not all your time in college will be spent in the classroom. Scope out the surrounding town to see what types of restaurants, clubs, stores and other establishments exist.



THE APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Your first step would be to either download the application or get a hardcopy of the same if you are personally visiting the campus from the International office of CBS.

2. Personally talk to the concerned counsellor, make up your mind about the course that you intend to join and then fill up the application form diligently.

3. There is a checklist of documents that need to be uploaded or submitted to the Institution along with the application form.

4. Once the application form is processed, your eligibility would be checked and a personal Interview scheduled either virtually or in person to assess your suitability to the program.

5. Once we find that you are fully eligible and your documents are in place, we communicate with the University and get the acceptance offer letter approval.

6. The student then needs to pay the rest of the fee due and complete the enrolment procedure and register for the classes.

7. Lastly, keep in touch with the counsellor and prepare yourself for arrival.
